- Contact families if their child is unwell or injured.
- Celebrate children's effort, progress and achievements.

Families will...

Our partnership with parents and carers

- Bring my child every day and on time for 8:45am, and collect at 3:15pm.
- Tell school promptly if my child will be absent.
- Keep my child home for 48 hours after vomiting or diarrhoea.
- Tell school about changes to contact details, health or family circumstances.
- Read ClassDojo messages and reply when needed.
- Come to meetings and work with school to support my child.
- Share books, listen to reading and practise phonics at home.
- Speak positively about school and celebrate my child's effort.
- Raise worries calmly and directly with school.
- Treat children, families and staff with kindness and respect.
- Not use their mobile phones on school grounds.

Children will...

Simple promises to talk through together

- I will come to school ready to learn and try my best.
- I will be kind, helpful and respectful.
- I will listen when other people are speaking.
- I will tell a trusted adult if I am worried or need help.
- I will follow our school rules so everyone stays safe and happy.
- I will look after our school, our things and nature.
- I will be proud of my achievements and celebrate other people.

Together, we will put the child first, speak openly and work as a team when things are difficult.
