WOW Day— Comparing an uncooked egg and a hard-boiled egg. How much weight can an egg hold?

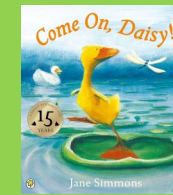
State of Being – Scientist

Skills and Knowledge

CL—Be able to talk about familiar books
PD— Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity and toothbrushing.
PSED— Develop appropriate ways of being assertive
LIT—Develop their phonological awareness, so that they can: spot and suggest rhymes
MATHS— Talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes (for example, circles, rectangles, triangles and cuboids) using informal and mathematical language: 'sides', 'corners'; 'straight', 'flat', 'round'.
UTW— Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant and an animal.
EX ART— Sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person ('pitch match').
