Focus-To begin to recognise emotions

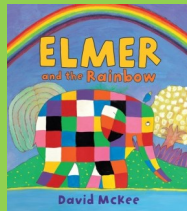
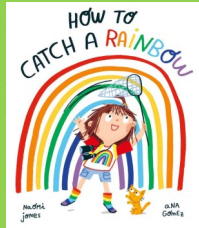

Skills, Knowledge & Sensory Experiences

Sensory play supports language development, cognitive growth, fine and gross motor skills, problem solving skills, and social interaction.

- Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle - I can demonstrate control of my body for example stretching up and crouching down
- Attention Autism-I can show an interest in adult led activities
- Curiosity Box - I can sustain attention in objects that interest me
- Emotional Regulation - I am able to begin to recognize how I or others are feeling
